#### **Phonics**

All pupils across the school are grouped for phonics teaching which specifically takes place at 11:30am every day. Children are taught in small groups of approximately 7-8. Using the Letters and Sounds programme as a starting point we feel this highly targeted and individual approach enables teaching to be tailored to specific needs. Solid understanding of oral phonics leads to effective spellings and spelling strategies.

In 2016 pupils in Year 1 achieved the expected standard in the DFE phonics screening putting us in the top 5% of schools in the country.

### Reading

From Year 1 upwards children use our *Accelerated Reader* scheme. Children read books then take an online quiz which examines their understanding of the text. Successes are rewarded during Celebration Assembly through certificates and word wizards. Reception children use a variety of banded books to support their reading. ERIC (Everyone reading in class) takes place daily at 10.45am across the school
