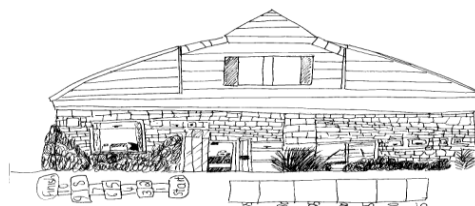

Sports Premium 2018/19

Funding Allocation

- 98 Children on Roll
- **£16980 unconfirmed until numbers on roll confirmed**

Objectives of Sports Premium 2018/19

- To encourage healthy, active lifestyles by providing opportunities for physical activity, in PE lessons and during break and lunchtimes and through competition.

Initiative 2018/19	
Stevenage Sporting Futures	£1500
To continue to provide pupils with Level 1 and Level 2 competition experience through participation in SFT 'On Tour' events, Mini-Olympics, Tag-Rugby, Cricket, Rounders, Netball, Tennis, Athletics and any new activities arranged by the organization for 2017/18. To access support and training for staff and young leaders.	

Initiative 2018/19	
Sports Apprentice	£9104
To support with the teaching of PE in school. To organize and run 'Active Lunch' sessions. To run sporting lunch and after school clubs. To be involved in planning and designing the new playground fitness equipment and monitoring its use.	

To monitor engagement in extra-curricular physical activities, using the school tracker and School Games Mark website.

To support the subject leader in the school's application for the School Games Mark.

To increase the profile of Sport in the school, by overseeing the management of the school sport notice board, liaising with SFT on competitions.

To organize sports and PE equipment, including lunchtime equipment.

Resources to support the teaching of PE

£1350

Funding allocated to continue to update and replace broken equipment. Including a set of new football posts and active playtime equipment.

Approximately £100 of this allocated to purchase badges and medals to reward and motivated children

Initiative 2018/19

Redevelopment of the school playground

£5000

Funding allocated to design and install outdoor gym and fitness equipment to create a trim-trail that can be used by all children at break times and lunchtimes including PE lessons. Equipment will/may include items such as:

- Sit up benches
- Slalom machines
- Walker/stepper machines
- Balance beams
- Tai Chi disks
- 'Daily Mile' Trail

Prices are approximate at this stage and the school will look to generate additional funding via grant applications and fundraising to supplement the £6000 from the Sports Premium budget.
