Actions for school:

- Share findings of survey with the parents and highlight key findings.
- Key Stage 1 Classes Additional work on what to do if you see something that upsets you online, through regular inclusion in Computer Science lessons, but also displays and posters in classes to provide visual reminder.
- Key Stage 1 Classes Educate children on how we make the internet safe for them at school.
 Teach about firewalls and safety features on the websites we use.
- All classes Support parents with further information about safe internet use and gaming for children
- Key Stage 2 Classes Signpost parents to guidance around social media platforms and online games
- Key Stage 2 Classes Educate children on the risks of playing/chatting with people online that they
 do not know in real life.
- Key Stage 2 Classes Further work, on how to behave safely and kindly online. Teachers to explore
 further how/why pupils have experienced others being unkind (is it a friend destroying their
 minecraft builds when playing together online, or unkind chat/bullying behaviours on social media).
 This will be through continued internet safety content delivered as part of Computer Science
 lessons, discussions in PSHE and through collective worship time, posters and displays in class.
